Stanley Edward Anderson has been selected for a National Research Council Senior Research Associateship award. The honor has allowed him to conduct studies at UCSB during a sabbatical. Working with UCSB chemistry professor Michael T. Bowers, Mr. Anderson, a chemistry professor at Westmont College, has been analyzing molecular structures using ion chromatography/mass spectrometry techniques perfected by the Bowers
